REQUIRED SERVICES: The University seeks a consultant to provide Roofing and Waterproofing Consulting Services during the design and construction phases of various capital improvement projects, and will include the peer review of building envelope components and systems criteria; quality assurance; budget analysis; written reports and documentation; and other construction administration services as required.

Qualified firms shall have relevant consulting experience and demonstrated ability with the following Design Build projects:

- Engineering, Science, and R&D Laboratories
- Classroom, Auditorium, and Office Buildings
- Student Housing and Recreation Facilities
- Parking Structures
- Hospital and Healthcare (including OSHPD)

ESTIMATED CONTRACT DURATION: 4 Years

Services will be authorized on an “as-needed” basis and are contingent upon project approvals, capital funding, and the quality of services delivered by the design professional.
